Be it further Resolved, that the applicant will provide proof of insurance and the letter of indemnity to the Town in a form acceptable to Counsel to the Town.

B. New York State Liquor Authority Special Event Permit Application – RiverJam Summer Concert Series and Fireworks Celebration

Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Ossining hereby authorizes the Supervisor to sign the Landlord Authorization Form for the New York State Liquor Authority Special Event Permit Application made by Sing Sing Kill Brewery, LLC, Wanna Sip LLC, and Brothers Fish and Chips for the craft beverage corral at the RiverJam Summer Concert Series and Fireworks Celebration at Louis Engel Park on Fridays, July 3, 11, 18, & 25, and August 8, 15, & 22, 2025 with rain dates of August 29, 2025, and September 5, 2025; and

Be it further Resolved, that the applicants will provide proof of insurance and the letter of indemnity to the Town in a form acceptable to Counsel to the Town.
