The Village of Sleepy Hollow and Village of Croton are going to be renewing their contracts soon. Earlier this year, the Village of Croton amended its contract to add extra EMT hours. The Mayor of Sleepy Hollow recognized OVAC for the great work they do.

There was no continuing business. A request was made for a copy of MHAD committee bylaws to be send to the committee. Should no bylaws be located, it was recommend for the MHAD committee to begin discussions on creating them.
