The existing pool and the lower deck are 6ft away from the retaining wall on one side of the lower deck. There is also a 2 foot distance between the retaining wall and the vinyl fence which is above the retaining wall of 11 Gualtiere lane's property. I am humbly requesting a 4 foot Variance from required ten foot distance necessary to meet zoning board standards.

The Property is located on the cul de sac of Gualtiere lane, triangular in shape going down hill(West to East direction). The pool and surrounding lower deck are behind the house and not visible to the street. The entire backyard is enclosed with a vinyl fence and tall, evergreen trees. There is no detriment to the neighborhood. I bought the property on December 5th, 2020 which came with the pool and deck. The title search was done on 10/05/2020 by Madison title agency which returned clear without any building violations upon the time of closing. It has now come to our attention that there is no CC for the pool and lower deck around the pool. It would be a significant financial hardship to move the deck and the pool. Due to these circumstances, we kindly request a 4 foot variance.
